Not only do the winners receive bragging rights, but 1st place gets \$100 cash prize, 2nd place gets \$50, and 3rd gets \$25!

1. What we’re looking for:

Photos of Agriculture in Benton County – photos that showcase soil and water conservation will be given extra points during judging.

3. Photograph Requirements:

- All photos must be submitted by Friday, August 10th, 2018 at 11:59pm.
- Photographs must be in high resolution digital format – all files must be landscape 2:3 aspect ratio and at least 920 x 1370 pixels
 - o 1st place photo will printed at 24”x36” landscape orientation.
- Photos must be in Benton County, Iowa.
- Photo must have been taken in the years of 2016, 2017, or 2018.
- Photo must be a single work of original material taken by contestant.
- Minor burning, dodging and/or color correction is acceptable. Hand tinting is acceptable, as is cropping. Fish-eye lenses are acceptable. High dynamic range images (HDR) and stitched panoramas are acceptable only if

the combined parts are all made at the same time. Any changes to the original Photograph not itemized here are unacceptable and will render the Photograph ineligible for a prize.

- **Each person is limited to three photographs for submission.**
- The photo must not contain material that violates or infringes on another's rites, including but not limited to privacy, publicity or intellectual property rights, or that constitutes copyright infringement.
- The photo must not contain material that is unlawful, in violation of or contrary to the laws or regulations in any state where photo is created.

4. Contest Prizes:

Will be determined and posted online no later than August 31st, 2018. Judging will be conducted by a committee appointed from the Benton County community.

- a. 1st place: \$100 reward and a 24"x36" photo on USDA Office Wall with name/recognition
- b. 2nd place: \$50 reward and a 16"x24" photo on wall with name/recognition
- c. 3rd place: \$25 reward and an 8"x12" photo on the wall with name/recognition

5. Photos:

All photos will be put on the Benton SWCD and Benton/Tama Nutrient Reduction Demonstration Project (Benton/Tama Project) Facebook Page once the contest is complete!
